

WPC DECKING TILES INSTALLATION

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INSTALLATION GUIDE

Step 1

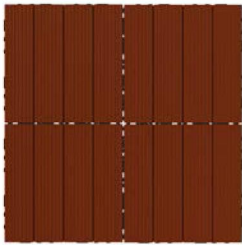
Prepare your surface

If you are laying your Deck Tiles onto an existing patio or hard standing then virtually no preparation is needed. Simply ensure the area is clean and free of any surface debris and give it a good sweep with a stiff brush. If you are planning to lay your Deck Tiles onto a hard surface with an uneven terrain or minor imperfections you may need to level the surface first with some patching compound or filler.

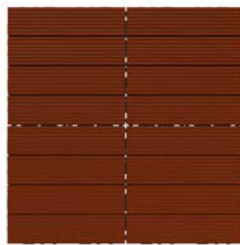
Step 2

Choose the pattern you want for your Deck Tiles

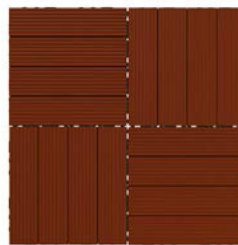
Once you've measured the area and calculated how many tiles, corner trims and edge trims you will need to complete your project, you should decide on the direction in which you wish to lay your tiles to create the desired impact. You can vary between Charcoal and Teak tiles for added interest.

Chequered



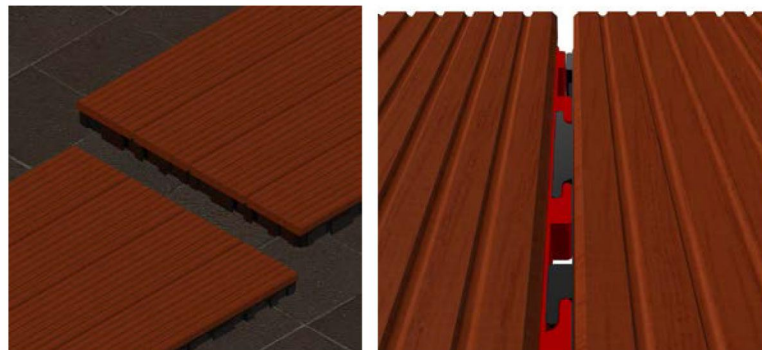

Step 3

Place the Deck Tiles next to one another and lock together

Start laying your interlocking Deck Tiles from one corner of the area to be covered. If your decking area does not adjoin to a wall you may choose to start your deck using Deck Tile Edge and Corner Trims to give a clean finish to your design.

To get started, place the first tile into position and then lock the adjacent tile into place by pushing down on the edge of the tile to activate the connecting tabs on the sides of each tile.

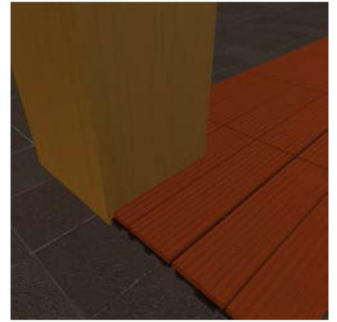
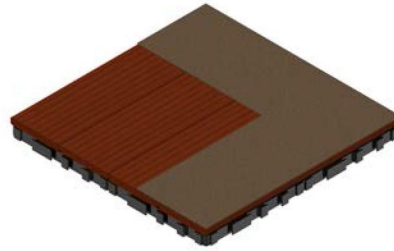


Place Deck Tiles side by side and push down to lock into place

Step 4

Easily cut your Deck Tiles to fit any area

If the area you wish to tile contains posts, angles, corners or pipes, then you can cut your Deck Tile to fit using simple tools such as a jigsaw or a regular handsaw. If you are not confident in your desired shape, try making a simple template out of light cardboard the same size as the tile to act as guidance and to avoid any errors in cutting the tile shape. Ensure you check the location of screws in the plastic base prior to cutting.



A cardboard template can be used as a guide to help when cutting

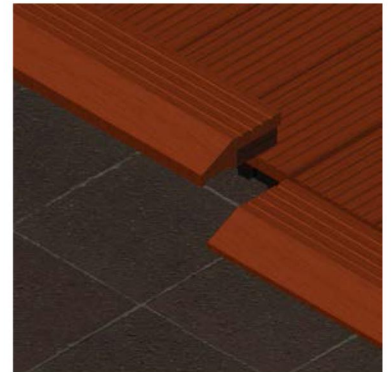
Step 5

Add the finishing touches

Continue adding your interlocking tiles until the complete area is covered and all the tiles are securely locked into place.

Add Deck Tile Corner and Edge Trims as necessary to conceal any exposed areas of your deck and provide a professional finish.

Deck Tile Corner and Edge Trims also use the same interconnecting in-built tabs for quick and easy installation,



Once your Deck Tile decking area is complete, simply brush down your deck and it is ready to enjoy immediately.

The plastic grid base allows water to drain freely under the decking tiles and the open structure of the base provides excellent air circulation preventing mould and mildew in damp and dark locations – meaning your Deck Tile decking area should be virtually maintenance free for years to come.
